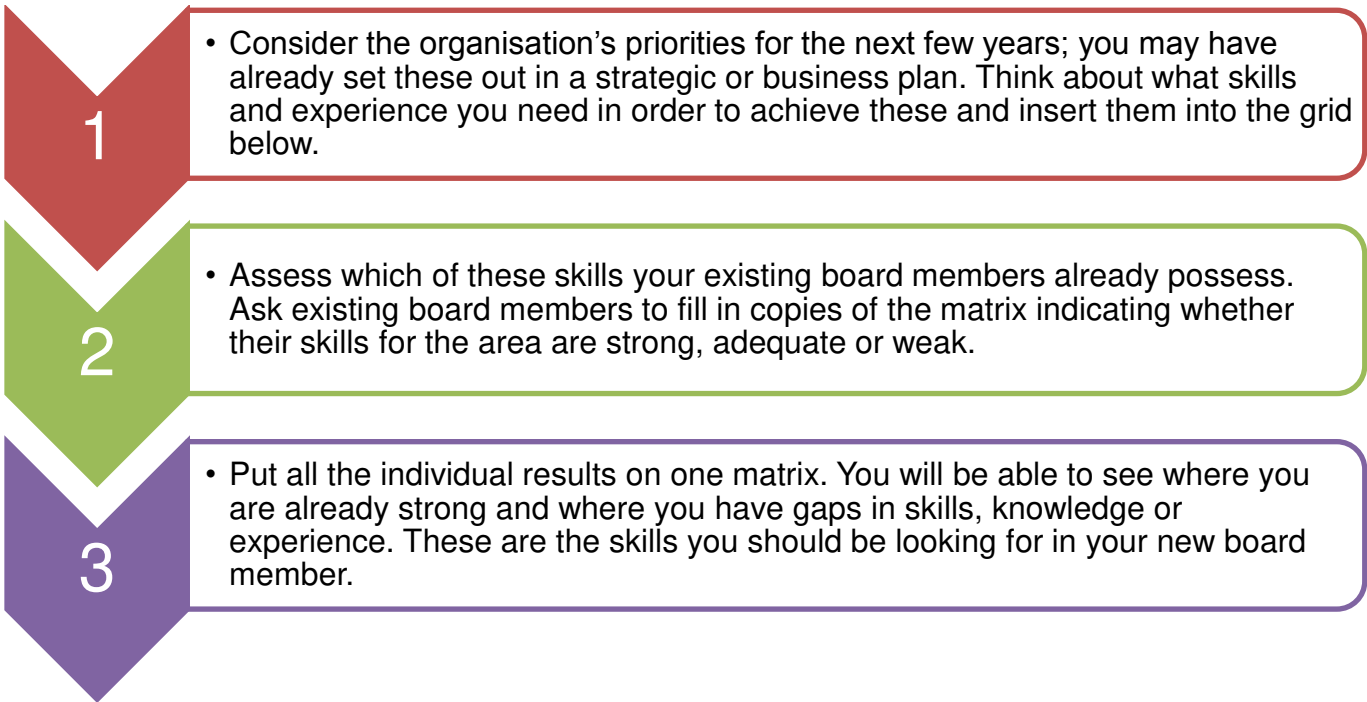


Skills Assessment Matrix
