

Background

- Christie Commission on the future delivery of public services
- Dr Campbell Christie produced the report in 2011

- The main points raised in the report were:
- Reforms must aim to empower individuals and communities receiving public services by involving them in the design and delivery of the services they use.
- Public service providers must be required to work much more closely in partnership, to integrate
 service provision and thus improve the outcomes they achieve.
- We must prioritise expenditure on public services which prevent negative outcomes from arising.
- And our whole system of public services public, third and private sectors must become more
 efficient by reducing duplication and sharing services wherever possible.

Why?

- Involving communities will lead to better provision for communities
- Organisations can represent their service users by making sure they realise the importance of taking part from a democratic perspective
- Organisations can reach those who access services so that engagements include communities of interest
- Give communities of interest voice and empower communities to know how to use that voice in an informed way
