We are giving parents the opportunity to have their voices heard by hosting a group discussion.

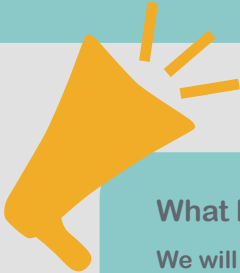
#### **Our aim?**
