- A chance for people to express their own dreams and collaborate to find common ground

In short, Philippa will explain how it works and when it is useful, and there will be a chance to practise together and share feedback.

Philippa Bonella is a freelance consultant working with third sector organisations on strategic planning, change management and governance improvements. Before becoming a consultant in 2016, she worked for 20 years in management roles across the third sector at Scottish, UK and international levels.
