Fares must be paid at or prior to the time of travel.

Monday 8th April Silverbirch Garden Centre Carluke

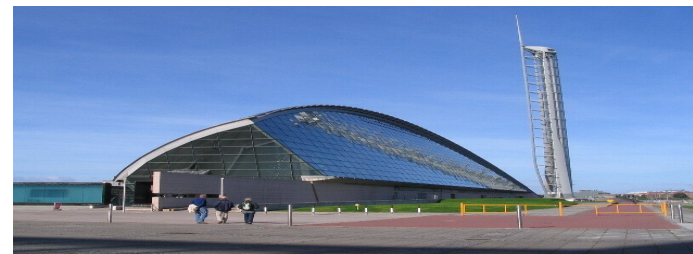
