We cover a range of issues such as accessing public services, welfare benefits, housing, employment, inequality, discrimination and reporting hate crime. We can also provide language support if required.



Third-Party Reporting Centre

We understand Hate Crime can have a hurtful, long-lasting impact. Our team can support you in reporting Hate Crime to Police Scotland, whether you are a victim, witness or carer.

Our OISC Level 1 Immigration Advisors can assist you with immigration enquiries, including Asylum and Protection, and the EU Settlement Scheme.
